

Sky Now — Quick Start

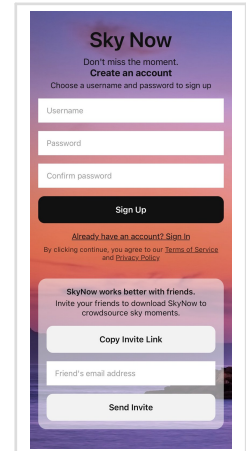
Know the moment something worth stepping outside for is happening near you.

1. Install

iPhone: Install the free "TestFlight" app first, then tap your invite link and tap **Install**. **Android:** Email SkyNowSupport@gmail.com with your name and Google email to request access, then tap the link you're sent and tap **Install**.

2. Create Your Account

- 1 Open the app and tap **"Sign Up."**
- 2 Choose a **username** (not your real name, unless you'd like) and a **password**.
- 3 Tap **"Sign Up."** No email address needed.

You'll be asked to allow **location** (shows sightings near you — your exact spot is never shared) and **notifications**. Say "Allow" to both.

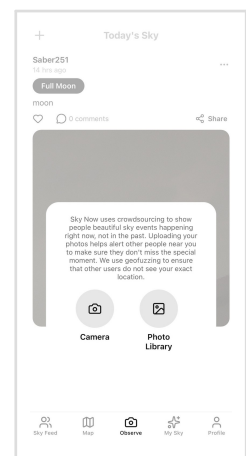
Why it's exciting: when 2+ people nearby report the same kind of sighting around the same time, everyone signed up for live alerts gets notified instantly. Just by posting, you could help alert others nearby to something happening right now.

3. Find Your Way Around

Five buttons along the bottom: **Sky Feed** (what's nearby recently), **Map** (pins of recent sightings), **Observe** (share your own photo), **My Sky** (tonight's moon phase & sunset), and **Profile** (your posts & settings).

4. Share a Sky Photo

- 1 Tap **"Observe."**
- 2 Choose **Camera** or **Photo Library**.
- 3 Pick what you saw (sunset, rainbow, etc.) — more than one is OK.
- 4 Add a caption if you'd like, then tap **Share**.
